

Environmental and quality policy

BetaPack A/S is a trading company focused on forming partnerships with suppliers who can meet our stringent quality and environmental standards. We deliver customized quality products across all our business areas, heavily relying on choosing the best and most responsible suppliers.

In our Purchasing policy, it is defined what we expect from our suppliers and the standards we require from them. BetaPack A/S has decided primarily to source from suppliers located and producing in EU and EEA countries. This is from an environmental perspective to minimize transportation, but also to ensure we are close to our suppliers and their production sites – so we can together systematically and effectively develop and improve current processes.

Environmental policy and objectives

BetaPack A/S commits to comply with relevant environmental legislation. We will continuously work to stay informed about changes in legislation in cooperation with our suppliers. We will actively work to reduce the environmental impact of our products and their transport, focusing on the following actions:

- Reduce the consumption of raw materials, auxiliary substances and energy
- Ensure our products are reusable or recyclable to the greatest extent possible
- Replace environmentally hazardous substances with safer alternatives
- Focus on reducing CO₂ emissions in cooperation with our suppliers and logistics providers

BetaPack A/S is a FSC®-certified company and prioritizes working with suppliers certified according to ISO 14001. BetaPack A/S works with selected UN Sustainable development Goals, is a member of the UN Global Compact and thereby adheres to the 10 principles within Human Rights, Labor, Environment, and Anti-Corruption.

Quality policy and objectives

BetaPack A/S aims to deliver customized quality products and ensure that customers receive products that meet agreed requirements and expectations. This is achieved through close partnership and dialogue with customers and suppliers. Therefore, only quality-conscious suppliers are selected, as they contribute to the above.

Quality deviations are continuously registered and evaluated and used as a tool to improve our internal workflows and processes at our suppliers. It is prioritized to work with suppliers certified according to ISO 9001. Audits and assessments of all significant suppliers are conducted as needed, their processes and actions are controlled, and continuous improvements in their processes are pursued.

Additionally, there are several other certifications and labeling schemes that suppliers must possess depending on the business area they provide products for:

- BRC or HACCP certification
- CE marking
- Documentation and labeling of products for certified sustainable constructions
